

## **Job Description – Contract Environmental Litigation Position – Seattle, WA**

The work entails assisting senior attorneys in preparing claim letters to insurance carriers and responding to their discovery requests. Contract term is anticipated to be 4-6 months; hourly rate dependent on experience and credentials.

The successful applicants must have one to three years substantive experience in environmental law and/or environmental litigation. Among qualified candidates, the most important qualifications in our evaluation will be academic credentials, references, litigation experience, demonstrated commitment to environmental law, writing skills, and a willingness to work hard (including potential travel).

### **Experience Required.**

#### **– Environmental Law Experience.**

- These positions require one or more years substantive experience with contaminated site cleanup and/or environmental insurance coverage. No applicant will be considered who has not worked in a Superfund or similar environmental cleanup matter.

#### **– Litigation Skills.**

- Court and administrative proceeding work. Experience with motion practice desirable, but not required.
- Discovery. The attorney must be able to respond to discovery requests with minimum supervision. Must have experience working on document review and production, preparation of an administrative record or assembly of discovery documents, and the preparation of privilege logs.

#### **– Technical Skills.**

- A technical scientific background, particularly in geology, hydrology or chemistry is helpful, but not required.

**Minimum Education Requirements.**

Graduation from a top tier law school or participation on Law Review.

**Submittals.**

A minimum of three (3) substantive pieces of original written work product must be submitted, along with a resume, law school and undergraduate transcripts, three or more references and a cover letter indicating why the candidate is interested in Marten Law.

Attorney must be willing to travel locally, and throughout Oregon and Washington.
